

LSC FACILITY HIRE RATES

A. SUBSIDISED ARTISTS' RATES

These rates are subsidised for individuals to develop their own creative, artistic and professional practice and who are working without funding. Supported by the Arts Council.

1. WORKSPACE BAYS – space & basic energy only in the following areas:

Metal, patination, wax room, glass, stone, large fabrication, mouldmaking, woodwork, ceramic, polishing, darkroom, studios:

€10 per day, up to: 7 days €50, 14 days €80, 21 days €110, month €130.

Energy charge for use of own power tools and equipment - 50% of above rates.

2. PRIVATE STUDIO – space & basic energy only:

€15 per day, up to: 7 days €65, 14 days €90, 21 days €120, month €160.

3. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT RESIDENCY - Includes a private studio with access to all the technical areas **including most equipment** and basic energy - €400 per month.

4. PROJECT SPACES (Sheehans 22sq.m. and Factory 54sq.m.)

€20 per day, up to: 7 days €75, 14 days €120, 21 days €160, month €190.

5. GALLERY – 322sq.m.

Private use - €30 per day, up to: 7 days €110, 14 days €150, 21 days €190, month €230.

Public exhibitions and events – 1 day €100; 7 days €500

Gallery has internet access, is unheated and not invigilated – For heating add €6 per hour. Hire time includes setting up and uninstalling work.

6. LIBRARY, ARCHIVE AND RESEARCH CENTRE (LARC)

Heated with broadband and access to kitchen etc. Access from 10am – 5pm Mondays to Friday.

Library access with or without use of 2015 iMac with Adobe Creative Suite CS5, high speed fibre broadband, A4 printer, photocopier and scanner: €5 for half day; €10 per day.

Archive access with 2015 iMac: €10 for half day; €20 full day.

Printing charge: - **B&W** - 20c per A4 sheet; 60c A3. Colour - €1 - A4, €2 - A3

7. DIGITAL STUDIO - 2006 iMac with Adobe Creative Suite CS5, wifi high speed fibre broadband, A3 printer, photocopier and scanner - €5 half day; €10 full day. Printing charge – see above.

8. TRADITIONAL PRINTMAKING - Etching, lithography & silk screen: Includes tracing, blotting and newsprint papers, acids, grounds, meths, turps, white spirit, degreasing materials, etching tools and access to Dark Room & Digital Studio. Paper, inks, special cleaners, plates, substrates and screens are extra, if available.

€10 for half day; €20 per day, up to: 7 days €75, 14 days €120, 21 days €160, month €190.

9. DARK ROOM (incl chemicals, enlargers, trays, exposure unit, drying etc)

€10 for half day; €15 per day, up to: 7 days €75, 14 days €120, 21 days €160, month €190.

10. WOODWORK - incl. woodworking power tools.

€10 for half day; €15 per day, up to: 7 days €75, 14 days €120, 21 days €160, month €190.

11. METALWORK

€10 for half day; €20 per day, up to: 7 days €90, 14 days €140, 21 days €190, month €230.

Forge – incl coke.

Welder (Arc and Tig) - excl. rods.

Sandblaster

Sand Boxes for sand casting - €10 per day.

12. STONE - hand tools and grinders not provided.

Banker only - €10 per day, up to: 7 days €50, 14 days €80, 21 days €110, month €130.

Banker with plant – incl waterwall and use of LSC/own compressor.

€20 per day, up to: 7 days €90, 14 days €140, 21 days €190, month €230.

13. CERAMICS

Kilns: €50 per firing, incl electricity.

Large Kiln - €150 per firing up to 1000 degrees - €200 for over 1000, plus electricity.

Lincoln wheel - €15 per day, up to: 7 days €75, 14 days €120, 21 days €160, month €190.

14. FOUNDRY

Furnace Hire: €80 per day excl. energy (approx €30 to €50), incl. powerwasher and sand blaster.

Kiln hire €30 per burn out excl. energy (approx. €100 to €130).

Bronze at cost, currently at €12 to €20 a kilo, if available.

Barrel Furnace - €30 per day incl gas.

Portable Furnace - €40 per day incl gas.

15. GLASS POLISHING LATHE

€10 for half day; €15 per day, up to: 7 days €75, 14 days €120, 21 days €160, month €190

16. ASSORTED EQUIPMENT

Hand tools - €5 per day.

Power tool - €20 per day.

Dell Data Projector - €30 per day.

Gas space heater incl gas €20 per day.

Desk Jet Printing – A4 and A3. Factory Office: 20c for A4; 60c for A3 each (max 10 sheets).

17. ENERGY USE for kilns and furnaces:

Per meter unit - Gas €4, Electricity 12c off-peak, 25c peak.

All ½ days = 4 hrs

Storage - We do not store work due to lack of space. Prices include VAT and are subject to availability, pre-booking and payment in advance. Prices may be subject to change from time to time.

Insurance – We recommend all users obtain personal insurance cover in case of accidents or incidents in which the Centre is deemed not to be at fault. Users are responsible for the insurance of their own machinery, equipment, stock and work (either finished or in progress).

B. COMMUNITY, VOLUNTARY & EDUCATIONAL GROUP RATES

Projects wanting space for workshops and meetings etc that are not in receipt of funding are in effect supported by the Arts Council and so can benefit from the above subsidised artist rates.

Daily rate for space and basic energy only - €10 per participant per day.

Hand tools - €5 per set of tools, per participant per workshop.

Use of materials, plant, specialist equipment and energy, see above subsidised artist rates.

Four or more consecutive days receives a 25% discount on the daily rate for space only.

Important conditions:

Insurance - Projects will need to have their own Professional and Public Liability Insurance, which must include an indemnity to LSC. A copy of this certificate must be sent to LSC before the project can commence.

Children - Projects working with vulnerable people must, by law, have; leaders who are Garda Vetted through a relevant organization; have done the HSE Children First Training (if there are a number of tutors then one trained tutor will suffice); and ensure the HSE advised ratios of adults to children is in place.

C. COMMISSIONS, FUNDED PROJECTS & COMMERCIAL RESEARCH

Public or private commissions, funded projects and Research and Development for commercial projects are priced as follows and is based on the amount of funding received:

Funding received for the project:

Under €2,000 – Double above subsidised artist rates.

Under €5,000 – Quadruple above subsidised artist rates.

Under €10,000 – Six times above subsidised artist rates.

Over €10,000 – Eight times above subsidised artist rates.
